



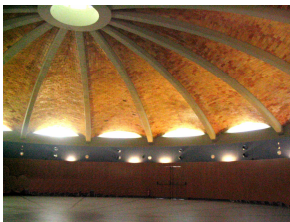

The Museu Agbar de les Aigües places at the disposal of companies and other interested organisations, diverse interior and exterior venues at the Museum, which are ideal for different types of events or activities: presentations, seminars, conferences, social events, celebrations, etc.

Moreover, the Agbar Water Museum offers the possibility of combining the holding of such events with private visits to the Museum's Permanent Exhibition.

El Dipòsit Circular (The Round Tank)



In these spaces, forming enormous water storage facilities, the treated water rests briefly before beginning its journey through the pipelines. The constant rise in the demand for water has obliged the construction of increasingly larger tanks.

Containing 2,000 cubic metres of fresh water until four years ago, the **Round Tank** (1955) now forms an original multi-purpose auditorium measuring 25 metres in diameter and over four

metres high, with excellent acoustics.

Description: A round space roofed with typical Catalan vaulting that uses flat bricks to create a gentle arch. It has recently been rehabilitated and prepared for musical performances and other activities. It has its own public-address system, projection equipment and climate-control system.

Dimensions: 500 sq m / height: 4 m on the perimeter, 8 m in the centre

Capacity: 320 persons seated, 450 persons standing

L'edifici d'Amargós i Samaranch (The Amargós i Samaranch Building)



hydraulic steam installation.

Constructive rigour and attention to detail are probably the fundamental aspects of the three bays designed by the architect Josep Amargós i Samaranch in 1905.

With this building, the company Aigües de Barcelona fulfilled its wish to create the most efficient drinking-water lift station. Each of the bays still preserves, in perfect condition, a representative sample of the original

Description: This is one of the halls of the *Modernista* building by the architect Josep Amargós i Samaranch. Both the space itself and the four large steam engines which preside over it are in excellent condition. This hall, which still has all its original elements, was recently restored and was not opened to the public until June 2004.

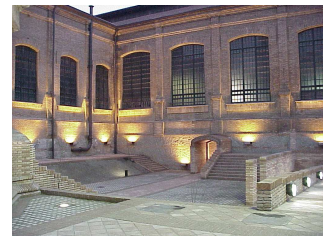
Dimensions: 510 sq m / height: 8-9 m

Capacity: 120 persons seated, 200 persons standing

Gardens

Sheltered behind the Amargós i Samaranch Building lies an inviting place which was originally the discharge area of the fumes produced by combustion of coal.

The rehabilitation of this space has preserved a small fragment of the passageway which joined the boiler and the chimney. Standing 54 metres tall, the chimney is a symbol of the industrial past and a veritable reference mark in the area.



Plaça dels Cedres (Cedar Square)

Description: This is a large area covered by wooden platforms and lawn, with a pond and some tall cedars. It is especially attractive at night since it is very well lighted with innovatively designed lamps and stands out against the unique backdrop of the illuminated façade of the *Modernista* building and the chimney.

Dimensions: 3,700 sq m

FUME DISCHARGE

Description: This is a space of moderate dimensions, sheltered from the wind and featuring good acoustics. It is presided over by the chimney and two of the building's façades. Brick textures and the green and reddish colours of the gardening predominate here.

Dimensions: 180 sq m
